
Before I could answer, my interviewer continued, "Your childhood holds a lot of repressed memories locked in there."

e live in a world full of battles, both within ourselves and around us. People are constantly in conflict, seeking supremacy or competing with others. Brothers turn against brothers, nations against nations, and kingdoms against kingdoms. All of these point to the end times, which we may be experiencing right now. There is currently the war between Russia and Ukraine, economic instability, and so many other global

issues.

Most importantly, we face the battle between our old nature and our new nature in Christ. This often leaves us uncertain about where we belong, knowing that we are still in this world and in this body, but not of this world. All of these struggles are the result of moving away from the foundation that should be laid in Christ.

Ephesians 2:20 reminds us that we are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Jesus Christ himself as the chief cornerstone. Moving away from this foundation has resulted in countless internal and external conflicts, as stated in our opening scripture: "They know not, neither will they understand; they walk on in darkness: all the foundations of the earth are out of course" (Psalms 82:5 KJV).

The Distraction (Genesis of the Problem)

Instead of focusing on finding our way back to Christ, which is where we should have never left, unfortunately, we are so self-absorbed and self-seeking that we are not looking in that direction. We dress it up, make it up, and follow all manner of doctrines and ambiguous religious rules and norms,

as expected of a believing Christian. This leaves us with multitude of spirits while still suffering on the inside. We also have many motivational and packaged conferences to address this issue, but the void remains unfilled, and the war intensifies.

We are presented with a pseudo-Jesus, a type who cares more about you receiving him, looking good on the outside, quoting the Bible, chasing the devil, and carrying out His bidding, while at the same time obeying sets of rules and regulations that have nothing to do with who Jesus really is.

As a result, we have people who call themselves Christians but are not Christ-like, acting like zombies with any soul or spirit. The pseudo-Jesus is more interested in your external appearance than what is happening inside you, so I ask you right here and now, "Which Jesus were you served?" To be Christ-like is more a state of being than the charade that is going on today. You must first put on a nature before the outlook.

What Jesus Is More Concerned About

Jesus is more concerned about what is going on inside of us than what we present to others. In Hebrews 10:5b, the Bible says "Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not, but a body hast thou prepared me." This means that whatever we present from a heart that is not rooted in Christ is a waste of time. That's why the focus of sin in the New Testament shifted from action to intention, as our motives are essential.

Our stability and growth come from within, but many people are still struggling with inadequacies and imaginary issues. For instance, the loss of a loved one can be painful, affecting almost everything in our lives. Some individuals are still dealing with childhood hurts, low self-esteem, and a lack of confidence. Hurt people can unintentionally hurt others, leading to personality disorders, unhealthy competition, and tearing people down instead of working together as God expects.

To move forward, we must learn to release our fears and cares, especially the fear of failure, which often holds us back. As the psalmist said in Psalm 51:10, "Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me."

Psalms 55:22(AMP) says to "Cast your burden on the Lord [release it] and He will sustain and uphold you; He will never allow the righteous to be shaken (slip, fall, fail)."

Again, 1 Peter 5:7 (AMP) encourages, "casting all your cares [all your anxieties, all your worries, and all your concerns, once and for all] on Him, for He cares about you [with deepest affection, and watches over you very carefully]."

When we let go and let God, we yield to the words of our great Apostle Paul to present our bodies (hearts) as a living sacrifice in Romans 12:1 (KJV), "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, boly, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service."

The church of God over time has learnt to deal with issues by cutting unwanted trees. Beloved a tree you cut down will definitely grow back, it is only a matter of time but uproot the tree and there'll be no chance of it growing back. We must deal with this identity crisis not as regards the authority and Dominion mandate, our qualities and capabilities but first having a proper understanding of who and whose we are. Delving deeper, one must first know God and the

What We Must Deal With

We need to address, confront, and eliminate the internal energy, voice of inadequacy that we have entertained, and the voice that contradicts Jesus that we have become so accustomed to, so much so that it informs all our decisions.

While it is essential to have believer's classes and foundation classes in the church, we must not assume that people are familiar with God. Many are beginners and need to be taught from scratch. A person struggling with personality issues will have cracks in whatever they build, which is a significant foundational mistake. Such a person must be

counselled with a proper foundation of Christ established. We cannot assume that people are knowledgeable about Jesus as many put up a front and are only at a peripheral level, like non-believers.

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
example. When I received Jesus as my Lord and personal Saviour years ago, I did not know that an altar call was a one-time event. Every time I attended a Pentecostal church and heard an altar call, I would be out there in front. The funny thing is, I felt that every other person was too proud not to respond to the call. There was something about the altar call that stirred me up then and still does now. I always love that time in service.

We Must Be Taught Afresh

Believers need to be taught afresh. I once met a lawyer and respected 'elder' who served in a high capacity in his church. The Holy Spirit pointed him out to me and revealed that while he loved God and served diligently, he had not received Jesus and was not born again. I inquired and found this to be true, so I took the necessary steps to address it. My question is, how could such a significant detail be overlooked for a high-ranking member of the church?

Perhaps this grave oversight was due to assumptions based on his eloquence, poise, and other attributes. However, people can make the best speeches, be great orators, conduct themselves appropriately, and still not be born again. Self-righteousness is not true righteousness, and we need to continually emphasize this fact. Am I an expert on this? The answer is no. Based on my experiences however, I am moved to revisit the basics with this scripture in mind: "If the foundations be destroyed, what can the righteous do" (Psalm 11:3, KJV)?

The righteous can rebuild on God's truth. Every believing child of God should boldly confront their foundations and make necessary adjustments. Until we understand who we are, whose we are, and what was and is as regards our identity in Christ, we cannot stand boldly to fulfil our assignment here on earth, which is to establish God's Kingdom.

very believer must understand that man is not a product of the evolution theory or scientific experimentation. He is not merely a collection of cells or any other label the world has assigned him. Man is not self-sufficient and cannot function independently, for everything that exists was made by God and consists of Him entirely, not just in part. Without Him, there is no life. This means that anything that exists is either in, from, or by Him.

Growing up, I often wondered how we all came into existence. This thought was laid to rest when I attended catechism classes. My parents were staunch Catholics, and we were raised with strict Catholic values, such as not arriving late to church and observing devotion times. In my family, prayer times were non-negotiable and compulsory, and we were required to say the Rosary. Ephesians 2:10

In these times, we must recognize that just because something has been written in history does not necessarily make it true or the truth. Merely being passed down from generation to generation does not guarantee its veracity; it could be an age-old deception. We should be cautious about the materials we and our children are exposed to, so we don't get confused.

If children can understand academic concepts, they can comprehend God's teachings even better. They are never too young to learn about the Trinity (God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit). By doing so, we can protect their innocence and purity by blocking out imaginary friends, identity crises, perversion, and other negative influences.

Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves

on the earth."

Genesis 1:26-28

Just as a child born into a family can be easily identified by their looks, appearance, and even demeanour to belong to that particular family, so are we in God. Man is a spitting image and likeness of God; we are His exact replica. If you ever wondered what or how God looks, look at yourself! Yes, you are His exact look-alike. You are made in His image and likeness, an offshoot of the Trinity, God in His totality.

To be made in God's image means to have His outlook and nature. The word "image," according to Strong's definition, refers to resemblance, hence a representative figure. This is how we exercise and establish the authority of God on earth.

As an adult, I now understand that my sisters carry the



But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints; Neither filtbiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of thanks. For this ye know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, bath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.

Ephesians 5:1-5

There is no better way we can demonstrate to God that we fear Him other than in the presentation of our bodies as living sacrifices.

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

Only then can we have access to be led by His Spirit into all truth. John 16:13a says, "Howbeit when be, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth." Because God has said His Spirit will no longer strive with man, "And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that

he also is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years (Genesis 6:3). Only the man whose spirit is submitted to Him in all things, knowing that He is all in all has access to God's Spirit.

Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear: For our God is a consuming fire.

Hebrews 12:28,29

4. Obey the King

Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God. Wilt thou then not be afraid of the power? do that which is good, and thou shalt have praise of the same: For he is the minister of God to thee for good. But if thou do that which is evil, be afraid; for he beareth not the sword in vain: for he is the

minister of God, a revenger to execute wrath upon him that doeth evil. Wherefore ye must needs be subject, not only for wrath, but also for conscience sake. For this cause pay ye tribute also: for they are God's ministers, attending continually upon this very thing. Render therefore to all their dues: tribute to whom tribute is due; custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; bonour to whom bonour.

Therefore, let's subject ourselves willingly to authority, obey and pray for them for they're of God and require such from us if they are to function properly.

I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; Forkings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.



Our Authority (Ability)

And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

Genesis 1:26

od not only made man in his image but gave man the authority to rule in His stead on earth dominating every strata, establishing His rule, His government and His kingdom on earth because he knows that man cannot function in his capacity as God without God's empowerment.

God As the Supreme

God is the supreme and only true God over all, He created all things and without Him was not anything made that was made. He was the force behind all creation and chooses to express Himself, handed it over to Jesus to be the head.

For to us a Child is born, to us a Son is given; and the government shall be upon His shoulder, and His name shall be called Wonderful Counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father [of Eternity], Prince of Peace.

Isaiab 9:6, AMPC

Jesus the Son is the Head of the Body and we all together that believe and have received Him are His body. So as the verse says the government is on His shoulder, Beloved without engaging semantics, the

shoulder is not located at the head but right after the neck. That is to say that, the burden of the Government of God and its establishment on earth is not upon the head (Jesus) but His body, (You and I) His family.

Man-Given Authority

The moment man (Adam) was created, he was given authority over all things that were created

Genesis 1:28 (KJV) - And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.

The Extent of Man's Authority

The authority of man cuts across every sphere of life. As stated in Gen 1:28, man was in charge of the fish of the sea (terrestrial Powers) signifying water, the fowls of the air (principalities) representing the air and creeping things (spiritual wickedness) referring to land. All these were given to man to dominate over not to talk of creating and recreating our world like our Father God.

Instances Where Man Established His Dominion, Power & Authority

1. Naming the Animals

One of the first instances Adam exercised authority was in the naming of the animals.

And out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought them unto Adam to see what he would call them: and whatsoever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof. And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field; but for Adam there was not found an help meet for him.

Genesis 2:19-20 (KJV)

Adam had the ability to name all the animals and apportioned them their duties according to their behaviour and habitat because of the authority and ability given to him by God.

2. Gathering the Animals into the Ark

It was that same authority in man at work in Adam that enabled Noah to gather and take all the fish of the seas, fowls of the air and every creeping thing upon the earth two by two into the ark.

And Noab went in, and bis sons, and bis wife, and bis sons' wives with bim, into the ark, because of the waters of the flood. Of clean beasts, and of beasts that are not clean, and of fowls, and of every thing that creepeth upon the earth, There went in two and two unto Noab into the ark, the male and the female, as God bad commanded Noab.

Genesis 7:7-9 (KJV)

3. Raining Down Different Plagues in the Land of Egypt

Moses and Aaron exercised the ability and authority in man when they commanded (ten plagues) judgement upon pharaoh and his people, when he refused to let the Israelites go from Egypt as instructed by God.

a. Turning Water into Blood

And Moses and Aaron did so, as the LORD commanded; and he lifted up the rod, and smote the waters that were in the river, in the sight of Pharaoh, and in the sight of his servants; and all the waters that were in the river were turned to blood.

Exodus 7:20

b. The Rain of Frogs

And Aaron stretched out his hand over the waters of Egypt; and the frogs came up, and covered the land of Egypt.

Exodus 8:6

c. The Rain of Lice

And they did so; for Aaron stretched out his hand with his rod, and smote the dust of the earth, and it became lice in man, and in beast; all the dust of the land became lice throughout all the land of Egypt.

Exodus 8:17

d. The Rain of Hail and Thunder

And the LORD said unto Moses, Stretch forth thine hand toward heaven, that there may be hail in all the land of Egypt, upon man, and upon heast, and upon every herb of the field, throughout the land of Egypt. And Moses stretched forth his rod toward heaven: and the LORD sent thunder and hail, and the fire ran along upon the ground; and the LORD rained hail upon the land of Egypt.

Exodus 9:22-23

e. The Rain of Locust

And Moses stretched forth his rod over the land

of Egypt, and the LORD brought an east wind upon the land all that day, and all that night; and when it was morning, the east wind brought the locusts. And the locusts went up over all the land of Egypt, and rested in all the coasts of Egypt: very grievous were they; before them there were no such locusts as they, neither after them shall be such.

Exodus 10:13-14

4. Commanding of the Ground to Open

Moses commanded the ground to open and swallowed the sons of Korah, who had been against his God given authority in the wilderness.

And Moses said, Hereby ye shall know that the LORD hath sent me to do all these works; for I have not done them of mine own mind. If these men die the common death of all men, or if they be visited after the visitation of all men; then the LORD hath not sent me. But if the LORD make a new thing, and the earth open her mouth, and swallow them up, with all that appertain unto them, and they go down quick into the pit; then ye shall understand that these men have provoked the LORD. And the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed them up, and their bouses, and all the men that appertained unto Korah, and all their goods.

Numbers 16:28-32

5. Commanding the Sun to Stand Still

With the authority at work in man, Joshua was able to stop the sun from going down until he was done fighting their enemies.

Then spake Joshua to the LORD in the day when the LORD delivered up the Amorites before the children of Israel, and he said in the sight of Israel, Sun, stand thou still upon Gibeon; and thou, Moon, in the valley of Ajalon. And the sun stood still, and the moon stayed, until the people had avenged themselves upon their enemies. Is not this written in the book of Jasher? So the sun stood still in the midst of heaven, and hasted not to go down about a whole day.

Joshua 10:12-13

In the New Testament

In the New Testament quite a lot was achieved by man as a result of the authority of Christ given to the early apostles like Paul.

So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.

Acts 19:12

And when Paul had gathered a bundle of sticks, and laid them on the fire, there came a viper out of the heat, and fastened on his hand. And when the barbarians saw the venomous beast hang on his hand, they said among themselves, No doubt this man is a murderer, whom, though he hath escaped the sea, yet vengeance suffereth not to live. And he shook off the beast into the fire, and felt no harm. Howbeit they looked when he should have swollen, or fallen down dead suddenly: but after they had looked a great while, and saw no harm come to him, they changed their minds, and said that he was a god.

Acts 28:3-6

NB; The fallen man was still powerful even in his fallen state because 'the gifts and calling of God are without repentance Rom 11:29 (KJV). So, the fallen man didn't fall short of his authority and power. The major thing he lacked was coordination, effectiveness and productivity in righteousness, and all this because he lost fellowship with the Father, and his thoughts became evil.

And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil

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continually. And it repented the LORD that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart (Genesis 6:5-6).



And Man Fell

And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eves, and a tree to be desired to make one wise. she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto ber busband with ber; and be did eat. And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons. So be drove out the man; and be placed at the east of the garden of Eden Cherubims, and a flaming sword which turned every way. to keep the way of the tree of life.

Genesis 3:6-7, 24

As we proceed into this book, one major thing we must know and understand is that many terminologies, concepts and ideologies used in the world are borrowed from God and His outworking. One of such terminologies is the **Brotherhood**.

God's Original Intention

The "Brotherhood" is an ordination from God for us to love, uphold, uplift, and look out for one another. This was His intention, that brother will look out for brother, none to stand alone, and not the rat race, cat and mouse outlook, competitions, dishonour

and tearing down each other we have. This has left cracks, and damages in the hearts of many, and this is the reason for the identity issues we see in the church today.

Putting each other down brings us back to the curse that was in the time of the first Adam as exhibited by Cain contrary to the intention our Father Abba made man in *Genesis 4:8*, "And Cain talked with Abel

his brother: and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him."

God made the first man and woman, (Adam and Eve) to start His own family on earth to raise a generation of His kind. The idea was to fill the earth with the God-kind, a people after His heart, image and likeness but they yielded to another voice, and a wisdom contrary to that of God.

Do you not know that to whom you present yourselves slaves to obey, you are that one's slaves whom you obey, whether of sin leading to death, or of obedience leading to righteousness?

Romans 6:16

We Do the Same Thing

Before we get judgmental, we do the same thing every time we steer away from God's way to find our own path, refusing to submit to our process, and wait on God until we are properly trained and guided. Many of us graduated ourselves before time while others never got into training.

God's Silence Doesn't Necessarily Mean "No"

I must tell you this truth, God's silence on certain issues doesn't necessarily mean a 'NO' but could mean "Hold on you are not yet ready for this." It's the will of God for us to prosper but the prosperity should never be at the expense of our soul. Our soul is much more important to God than any other thing. In 3 John1:2, the Bible says, "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in bealth, even as thy soul prospereth."

We Always Rush Off

We are often in a hurry to take the bull by the horn without considering its stubborn nature, and how mighty such a fall can be. Adam and Eve were not different from us today, I have come to know that there is sin against purpose. Adam, Eve, and also King Saul are in this category. They stood in the way and almost truncated the move of God as in the case of Ananias and Saphira when a fresh season being ushered in by the Father.

After the destruction of the world as we see in Genesis 1:2, "The earth was formless and void or a waste and emptiness and dark was upon the

face of the deep." God was putting together a whole new world; a system devoid of any other that would establish His rule and sovereignty. This He packaged by Himself and by Himself man was made in His very essence and substance. He breathed His life into man, no wonder man was denied access to the tree of life as it would have been disastrous for sin to reign eternally on earth.

And the Lord God said, "Bebold, the man has become like one of Us (Father, Son, Holy Spirit), knowing [how to distinguish between] good and evil; and now, he might stretch out his hand, and take from the tree of life as well, and eat [its fruit], and live [in this fallen, sinful condition] forever"— therefore the Lord God sent Adam away from the Garden of Eden, to till and cultivate the ground from which he was taken. So God drove the man out; and at the east of the Garden of Eden He [permanently] stationed the cherubim and the sword with the flashing blade which turned round and round [in every direction] to protect and guard the way (entrance, access) to the tree of life.

Genesis 3:22-24

The Peculiarity of the Fall of Man

The peculiarity of the fall of man wasn't just about

Adam and Eve yielding to a contrary voice, strange knowledge I may say but more because they broke a major code in Kingdom culture: the Brotherhood we have in Him. This majors on looking out for one another to build up and not to despitefully use each other or tear down ourselves. Adam got it wrong when instead of correcting Eve, he succumbed to her fallen state. This is wrong and mirrors a funny definition of love. Love is a nature we have in God and not that which is borne out of emotions or any form of carnality which spans to a myopic mindset of everyone feeling the same pain you feel or are feeling, or that others must fail because you did. If you are in this category, you are in Christ but not of Him.

Cain also broke the code as he mirrored the same anomaly discussed here when he killed his brother even after God pre-warned him as seen in Genesis 4:7,9, "If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, sin lies at the door. And its desire is for you, but you should rule over it." Then the Lord said to Cain, "Where is Abel your brother?" He said, "I do not know. Am I my brother's keeper?"

This is a total error; one we must look out for. Sin is constantly at our door and we must rule over it, or do

you not know that self-conceitedness, selfishness, self-righteousness, over indulging one's self are all sins against God? Yes! Our sin nature has been taken but we must guard against acts of sin that are still attaching themselves to our members. We must rule over them. Our dominion mandate is bringing to subjection, obedience and alignment anything that is contrary to God's order.

The Right Order of Things

Jesus walking the earth was still in sync with God the Father and Holy spirit, a constant open communication line as seen in John 5:19, "Then Jesus replied, "I assure you: The Son is not able to do anything on His own, but only what He sees the Father doing. For whatever the Father does, the Son also does these things in the same way."

We are to emulate this order and structure without any form of distraction. We must do things how God does it, see as He sees, and become like Him. This is the essence of the coming of Jesus to bring us back to our place in God, and restore us not just to our place in God, but to His order and rule for only then can we carry out fully the mandate of dominion. He is returning and expects to see us not in a fallen state but in the fullness of the glory He attained for us to be

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a spitting image of Him.



Jesus- Our Kinsman Redeemer

For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive. But every man in his own order: Christ the firstfruits; afterward they that are Christ's at his coming.

1 Corinthians 15:21-23

kinsman—redeemer under the Mosaic law, is a male relative who is saddled with the responsibility to act on behalf of a relative who was in trouble, danger or had any need. In our case, the first Adam lost the authority conferred to him by the Father and to get back the dominion he lost so as to establish God's rule on the earth, God had a plan.

To this end, the last Adam, our 'Kinsman Redeemer' was introduced to ensure the fulfilment of God's purpose and restore us back to God in His image and likeness.

"And so it is written, "The first man Adam became a living being." The last Adam became a life-giving spirit. However, the spiritual is not first, but the natural, and afterward the spiritual. The first man was of the earth, made of dust; the second Man is the Lord from beaven. As was the man of dust, so also are those who are made of dust; and as is the beavenly Man, so also are those who are beavenly. And as we have borne the image of the man of dust, we shall also bear the image of the beavenly Man."

I Corintbians 15:45-49

Relentless Love of the Father

Our God relentless in His love and pursuit will stop at nothing to see His will which is our ultimate purpose carried out to the last bit. This He showcased in His walk with Israel especially in the Old Testament. For as many times that they fell, there was restitution. God delivered them always with continuous sacrifices until the perfect sacrifice came on board. God went from just Israel to pouring out His love on the world. His intention being that all will be saved that believe in Him.

"For God so [greatly] loved and dearly prized the world, that He [even] gave His [One and] only begotten Son, so that whoever believes and trusts in Him [as Savior] shall not perish, but have eternal life.

John 3:16 (AMP)

The one-time sacrifice of Jesus liberated us from the curse of the law that was on our neck like a hangman's noose, a yoke of slavery to sin separating us morally from God but

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as mirrored in Galatians 3:13, "Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree")."

We Are Delivered and Eternally Yoked to Christ

How endless is this love of God for His family and to see the perfected end for them that He will stop at nothing until the fulfilment of that which He purposed.

For I know the plans and thoughts that I have for you,' says the Lord, 'plans for peace and well-being and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.

Jeremiab 29:11 (AMP)

It is with this mindset that the Father in His infinite mercy besought to redeem man and restore Him to his original state. This act of love and mercy would never have been possible if our Lord Jesus Christ wasn't brought into the equation. Just like Boaz, the husband of Ruth became her kinsman redeemer, so is Jesus to us. He is our redeemer, who purchased us with His blood, paid our debt in full and bought us back into His beloved.

He took our place, and not only did He serve our punishment of death but became sin on the cross and absorbed every plague and outworking of sin that we may be completely free from the nature of sin and death itself, and live in abundance of life eternal.

Let's look a bit into our heritage as stated in Ephesians:

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved. In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace".

Ephesians 1:3-7

If you read the entire chapter, it not only spells out our redemption but our current position in Christ. Beloved, there is no need to look down on yourself as He didn't pay for a few but for all of you. There is no need for timidity for the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and a sound mind such we are not lacking or giving room to low self-esteem nor even superiority to others for these are of the flesh.

The Identity of Our Kinsman

He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For by Him all things were created that are in beaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All

things were created through Him and for Him. And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist. And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence. For it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell, and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross. And you, who once were alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now He has reconciled in the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy, and blameless, and above reproach in His sight—

Colossians 1:15-22

What a delight to hear and know that Jesus was not just another man that walked on the street, another story told in the Bible nor another figment of someone's imagination. Beloved you can exhale at this point. What a relief to know that the burden of proof of salvation is not saddled on you, but someone else bore it and is still today and forever pleading your case.

Jesus our salvation liberated us not just from dead works but from a dead life—death itself as a state of being those metamorphoses into physical death. He didn't just save us from sin and death but He is our Mediator, our Kinsman Redeemer and the High Priest of our confession.

Now this is the main point of the things we are saying: We have such a High Priest, who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens, a Minister of the sanctuary and of the true tabernacle which the Lord erected, and not man.

Hebrews 8:1-2


He Is the Greatest High Priest

The old is completely gone, the old you, the old order is gone, and we now have a new life in Christ. Galatians 2:20 puts it this way, "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me."



The Race Called Christ

Therefore if anyone is in Christ [that is, grafted in, joined to Him by faith in Him as Savior], be is a new creature [reborn and renewed by the Holy Spirit]; the old things [the previous moral and spiritual condition] have passed away. Behold, new things have come [because spiritual awakening brings a new life].

he man that receives, believes and confesses Jesus as his Lord and personal saviour receives a brand new life in him.

What It Means to Be Born Again

Being "born again" simply means you are out of the old nature completely. This is why Scripture highlights that ALL things have become NEW. That is to say that what was, is no longer relevant, for the old is now obsolete. This is not just as regards your life. I am clearly convinced that this is not just as regards human life or nature but that when Jesus went to the cross, it was not just for humanity but for "the World".

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

Jobn 3:16

This verse didn't just say, God so loves mankind (humanity) but the world. This means the earth and all in it are implicated by the sacrifice of Jesus. I dare say then that anyone who receives Jesus as saviour, then believes in this truth as stated and is drafted into Christ by His Spirit is to establish this truth as received and convinced. We have received the ministry of reconciliation and it is then our responsibility in Christ as the ones in authority to enforce this truth, giving the life we have received to everything.

The new race then begins from the resurrection, a whole new creation which has never been in existence.

The new man in Christ is nothing like the old man. To everyone that has received Jesus, you were never in existence. The old you is completely gone and forgotten by the Father. You are blood washed, blood bought, Holy Ghost full with no

Romans 8:14 says, "For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God." We are mature in Christ to the extent we are submitted to the leading of the Holy Spirit and fully inclined to Him.

The race called CHRIST will not survive living according to the flesh. It is clearly stated in Romans 8:13, "For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live."

Simply put, living life as you once knew it is death, but living by the Spirit is life eternal. Delving deeper into this truth, you'll find that not only are our lives different, it also goes down to our warfare and responsibilities in Him.

For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of

Christ, and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled.

2 Corintbians 10:3-6

That you're still in your old body doesn't mean the old is still in existence. It means your spirit man is fully activated in its sensitivity to God. Fully restored, your spirit has the ability, and empowerment to function and operate fully as and in God, while the body awaits its total salvation at the coming of Jesus Christ, who is the Head of the Body of Christ. Our full transformation into the same image of the


Christ as held by Jesus, the Head of the Body is in fixing our gaze solely, completely on Him, and nowhere else so we become a complete match for Him.

2. Be mindful of What You Listen to

For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh, that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

Romans 8:1-4

Stand your ground. Resist the devil and he will flee;

he is that same old serpent with no new tricks. Concentrate on the power that brings him down. Beloved you are Spirit, Soul and Body and so you have the innate power to dominate in all realms. Refuse every lie of the devil, refuse his deception, refuse to let him keep you in constant pain, regret, and depression. Stop playing down on yourself. Never make the cross futile because Jesus paid the price in full and He beckons. Breakout of slave mentality, stop short-changing yourself. Strive for knowledge of God, stay in His arena, the arena of Wisdom. Our ignorance has kept the devil almost as king of this realm but he is not a king nor will he ever be. In Him I live and move and have my being.


His own, entirely his own
